New Immigration Rules

Please be aware that there have been some major immigration changes in the new AEB funding guidelines for 2021/22.

Students who have not been in the UK/EU/EEA for the last 3 years can no longer study as home students unless they fall under the following categories:

- · Refugee status
- · Discretionary Leave to enter or remain
- · Exceptional Leave to enter or remain
- · Indefinite leave to enter or remain
- · Humanitarian protection
- · Leave outside the rules
- · Afghan Locally Engaged Staff under the intimidation policy
- · The husband, wife, civil partner or child of any of the above
- · Section 67 of the Immigration Act 2016 leave
- · Calais leave to remain

Unfortunately, this means that students who have previously studied with us (who may be on a spouse, family visa etc.) and who have not been in the UK/EU/EEA, cannot study with us as Home students until their 3 years in the mentioned areas have been completed.
