There is also a busy enrichment programme throughout the year including talent shows, talks and sports along with a common room with game consoles and table tennis.



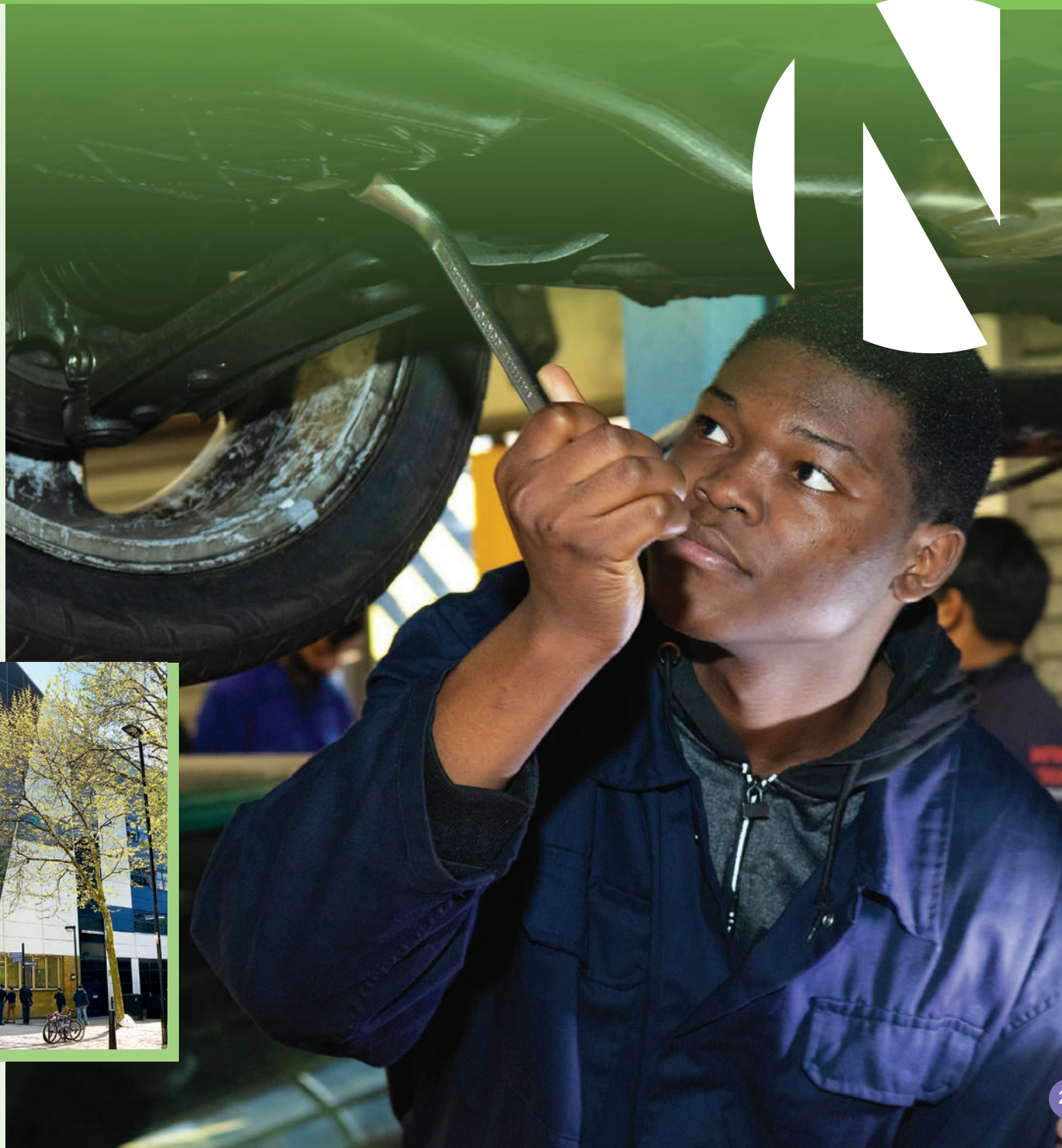
Tower Hamlets Campus

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Work Experience

As part of your study programme you will complete a work placement. This is **not optional**. It is just as important as your vocational course and English Language and maths.

This will vary from work experience of one week (35 hours) up to an Industry Placement of 45 - 60 days (or 315 - 360 hours). Your tutors will tell you the required amount for your programme of study.

Every student on a study programme will complete a period of work experience. If your course involves an industry placement, you will be told by your tutor. If your course does not include an industry placement but you would like to be considered for one, come and speak to us.

We aim to give you every opportunity to make sure that when you finish your course,

you are best placed to succeed, whether that is through higher level technical training, an apprenticeship, higher education or moving directly into employment. A meaningful work experience or industry placement will make you stand out against other applicants in the job market.

We'll support you in finding the right placement, though we do encourage you to approach employers yourself. This helps you to develop skills in applying for work.

You will have a designated contact at your campus who will come to your induction and start to work with you to secure your placement.

Entry requirements

Students applying to study A Levels will need to have a minimum of five GCSEs at grades 9-5 including English Language and maths and where relevant, the subject they wish to study. Some A Level subjects have specific entry requirements.

Exceptional students, who wish to study four A Levels, must have achieved grades 9-8 in a minimum of four GCSE subjects, including the subject they wish to study, where relevant.

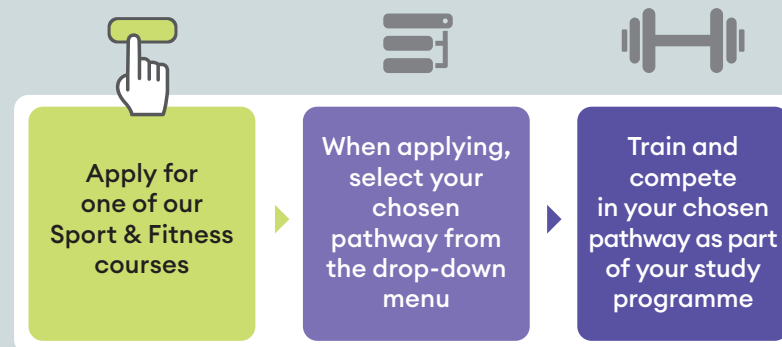
