




Step-by-Step Guide for 2024 entry

Before you begin your application look through these instructions and make sure you have gathered the following information in order to complete your application:

- GCSE Certificates showing grades and examining boards
- ❖ Any other qualifications, including those taken overseas
- Details of any paid employment (i.e. employers name and address and the date you started/finished)
- ❖ If you were not born in the UK, date you entered.
- Credit/debit card to pay for the online application fee of £27.50 for up to five choices
- Saturday 16 October by 6.00pm: Deadline for most medicine, dentistry, veterinary science and Oxford and Cambridge (Internal College Deadline – Friday 29 September 2023 by 3 pm)
- Wednesday 31 January 2024 by 6.00pm: Final UCAS deadline (Internal College Deadline Friday) 1 December 2023 by 3pm : A Level, BTEC, Access and other one year courses)







What about the buzzword?







Type in your choice of University- For some London Universities like Kings College London, type in University of London.

There is no need to enter your choices in order of preference- they will appear alphabetically in your application.

Your choices should all be similar. Do not apply for courses that are very different as this makes it difficult to write your personal statement. Your choices must be realistic otherwise you may be rejected.

Further details

You only need to provide information here if your chosen university or college has asked you to.

Point of entry

This tells the universities and colleges which year of the course you want to start, e.g. point of entry one is the first year of the course. If you wish to start in the first year of the course leave the box blank and you will automatically be considered for the first year. Enter 0 if you intend to take a foundation year – not all universities offer a foundation year so please check before applying.

If you've spoken to your chosen university or college and they are willing to consider your application to start the course after the first year, please enter the relevant number for the year, e.g. second year = 2, third year = 3, etc.

Click 1st year for a 3-year degree course. If you are applying for Foundation Year, click this but **make sure** in course section, the degree code relates to an actual foundation year course this is normally in the title or shows as a 4-year course with lower grade entry requirement.


All qualifications must be entered, even if you received an unsuccessful grade, if you are still waiting to take the final exams or if you are waiting for the results.

- A minimum of 1,000 characters- write more


You must check your spelling and grammar

No formatting allowed

UCAS' similarity detection service: every personal statement is run through software to check for plagiarism.

We strongly recommend you write the statement using a word-processor and paste it in to your application.

You can type your statement directly into the box or edit a statement you have pasted in.




Review and Submit

When you have completed all sections of your application and it shows 100% completed you will be able to review and submit from 5 September 2023. You will be asked for online payment at this stage.

Make sure that your application is complete and free from errors – make sure that you have it checked by your Pastoral Tutor or a member of the Careers Team.

It is your responsibility to check that the correct information is on your application form.



Review & Submit-

You will not be able to pay until 5 September 2023 when submissions can be made. *Make sure you are applying through the college and not as an individual*

IMPORTANT:

Once you have submitted your application, it will be released to the college to ensure that your reference and predicted grades are added. We can only do this, if you have applied through the college so please make sure you have done this before you pay and submit.

References & Predicted Grades

- ❖ A reference is a written recommendation from your teachers outlining your academic abilities and suitability for study at Higher Education.
- Predicted grades are not your target grades.
- ❖ Predicted grades are provided by your teachers these grades are not negotiable.
- Predicted grades are awarded from teachers based on your performance in lessons and assessments. They will be using their professional judgement based on evidence.

Final Checks

- Once you have submitted your application to us, your application will be given a final check.
- If there are errors, your application will be sent back to you to make the amendments.
- ❖ You will need to resubmit your application to us you will not be required to pay again!

Application Sent!

- Once your application is correct and error free, your application will have the reference and predicted grades added to your application.
- Correct applications will be sent to UCAS within 10 working days.
