ANTIBIOTIC RESISTANCE THREATENS OUR WAY OF LIFE...

The overuse of antibiotics in recent years means they're becoming less effective and has led to the emergence of "superbugs". These are strains of bacteria that have developed resistance to many different types of antibiotics, including MRSA.



While antibiotic resistance has been a concern for decades, it has become a major global health threat in recent years.
