

A-Levels (Advanced Levels) are two-year qualifications taken by UK students, typically between the ages of 16-18, to prepare for university entry. Students choose 3-4 subjects to study in depth, and assessments are based on exams and, in some cases, coursework.

In addition to regular lessons, students receive support from a personal tutor who monitors their academic progress and provides guidance on university applications. A-Levels are recognised internationally, so students can use them to apply to universities both in the UK and abroad.



London Accommodation Information 2025-26

We can arrange accommodation for students coming to London. This is organised by our partner Barnes Educational Services.

Most students take homestay accommodation, which involves living as a member of the family in their own room, but residential accommodation can also be arranged.



Care of Students Under 18 years of age

The safety and security of all our students is very important to us. We pay special attention to those students under the age of 18 by using a Safeguarding Policy which:

- Requires all staff to complete Safeguarding Awareness training
- Arranges for all students under the age of 18 to have a regular meeting with a personal tutor.
- Makes sure that students are aware of UK licensing laws for the sale and drinking of alcohol
- Checks that staff and homestays accommodating students under 18 complete enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service checks
- Makes sure that all students under the age of 18 who want to join off-site excursions have a signed parental agreement to do so
