How do I reset my password? - at home

You can reset your own password using Microsoft Authenticator App. Follow these simple steps, which show you how to do so.


You can reset your own password at home, but you need to be registered with Microsoft Authenticator first. If you are not registered, please click here to view instructions to set this up: Setting up multifactor authentication – the Microsoft Authenticator App.

Once you have a registered authentication method, you can reset your password by:

1. Browse to https://office.com and click **Sign in.**



2. Click Can't access your account.



3. Select Work or School account.



4. When prompted, enter your **email address** and the **CAPTCHA** code displayed in the image:




To recover your account, begin by entering your email address or username and the characters in the picture or audio below.



5. Choose whether to change your password (I forgot my password) or unlock your account (I know my password, but still can't sign in) then press Next.


This might happen because you tried signing in with an incorrect password too many times.


7. Finally, enter a new password and click **Finish** to set it. You will now be able to login with this password.

NB: Your new password will need to be at least 8 characters long for students & 12 characters long for staff; no other special character or complexity is required e.g. Ilovecollege
